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INIF Nail World Cup “Free-style”

Competition Rules

Competitive Time 2.5 hours (150 minutes)

Specification This is a free-style exhibition and the all kind of techniques are allowed including extension, art and mix of those with the competitors' choice.

Specific Rules

1. All kind of techniques are allowed (e.g. Sculpture, Tip overlay, Design sculpture, Gel, 3D, illustration, Airbrush, other kind of art or mix of those)
2. Preparation is allowed, but you have to start with natural nail.
3. Shaping or cut out tips prior to the start is allowed.
4. Nail materials ONLY.
5. Rhinestones, bullion fringe and other art materials are allowed, but NO ready-made product allowed, and you are ONLY allowed to make things during the competition.
6. Cut style and length are all free including the size of 3D.
7. NO background information allowed.
8. NO oil allowed. NO C-curve clip allowed. NO chamois buffer allowed. BUT shine buffer is allowed.
9. NO temperature control adjuster (e.g. pocket warmer) allowed. You have to put gels on the tray.
10. You have to write the techniques on the declaration card placed on the table prior to the start.

Judging Information

About Judgment

1. There will be the guest judges with approval of the INIF committee along with regular judges.
2. Make and show the new style of nails.

Pre-judgment

1. Materials and condition of nails.
- *You could use the light, UV light, compressor, and drill if noted on the application form.
 *You have to declare the watt of equipments on the application form.
 *Only 2 plug outlets are prepared.

Deduction of points

1. Not adhering to the rules.
2. Take things from personal belongings without permission.
3. Bad-mannered.

Disqualification

1. Exceeding technical time.
2. Continuing to work on model after competition.
3. Injuring model.
